

EMI Architected Materials Student Competition

Sponsored by: EMI Architected Materials Committee

Purpose:

- Increase student participation in the EMI conference,
- Improve students' ability to create high-quality digital content that can help them introduce their research to a wider audience
- Disseminate cutting-edge research on architected materials

Requirements:

- All entries must be a video with a maximum length of 3 minutes (no minimum length requirement)
- The video can follow any format but should have a description of its content (e.g. title screen)
- Note that the video is not meant to substitute the presentation or be a brief summary of it. It should be complementary (e.g. material design, synthesis, experiment, simulation) to the key findings presented at the EMI conference.
- No copyrighted materials (e.g. music) may be used in the video.

Deadlines:

- January 15, 2022 - Abstract submission deadline.
- March 15, 2022 - Express interest to participate in the competition by sending an email to Prof. Stavros Gaitanaros (stavrosg@jhu.edu)
- April 30, 2022 – Video submission deadline

Prizes:

- One winner and one runner-up will be selected. They will receive a certificate and be named as the Architected Materials student competition winners.

Process:

- The videos will be evaluated by members of the Architected Materials committee.
- The winners will be informed in May.
