WORKSHOP: Tenured. Now what? — Mentoring and career planning for tenure-track and recently tenured faculty members

Description: While the criteria to get tenure are usually explained by institutions that grant it, the path to promotion to full professor is often not as clear. Beyond promotion, it is sometimes difficult to set academic goals after a long period being “on track” for Ph.D., postdoc and tenure. This workshop aims to provide tools for academic career development and planning for scholars who are approaching tenure or have been recently tenured.

Georgia Tech ADVANCE Professors have experience assessing academic packets, discussing career options and building professional networks. They regularly hold discussions and facilitate trainings for faculty members. Georgia Tech faculty members who regularly participate in ADVANCE programs will deliver presentations on self-assessment, prioritization and networking. Then, workshop participants will be assigned a work group led by a Georgia Tech faculty member to discuss challenges, opportunities and actionable objectives.
